## Child-centred, Therapeutic Model

Our care model is informed by trauma theory and focused on healing. We embed therapy into every aspect of care to support long-term recovery and resilience in children and young people.

## Expert Support

You will have access to a KAA Social Worker/Case Worker 24/7 every day of the year. We have a dedicated caseworker to support every placement, and access to our in-house therapists and educational specialists.

## Comprehensive Training

We support our carers every step of the way, offering extensive training and 24/7 support. This includes access to innovative technologies, such as Virtual Reality, to enhance training and education.

## You'll also have access to:

- Regular visits, telephone contact and ongoing support from a qualified and suitably experienced social worker.
- Up to 21 night's supportive respite, if required
- Regular monthly support group meetings with other foster carers to share experience and knowledge.
- Social activities
- Engaging school holiday programs to ensure children and young people have fun and stay involved during breaks.
- Carer Buddy Program, connecting you with experienced peers for guidance and social gatherings/activities
